

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Theme

2011 will see no theme be enforced on artists.

Registration Fee

There is a registration fee of \$10 to be submitted with each entry before the closing date of Friday 15th July 2011. Photographers and poets are entitled to 2 entries per registration i.e. if there are 4 poems the entry fee is \$20.

Payment can be made directly to Churches of Christ Sport and Recreation Assoc in cash, EFTPOS or credit card. Cheques are payable to Churches of Christ Sport & Recreation Association or CCSRA. This payment includes entry for 2 people to the Festival on either the 30th July or 31st July 2011.

Categories

Painting – Open and People’s Choice

Poetry - Open and People’s Choice

Photography - Open and People’s Choice

Film - Open and People’s Choice

Sculpture - Open and People’s Choice

Age of Artists

The Expressions Creative Arts Festival (ECAAF) is open to people aged 16 and over.

Prizes

Prizes will be awarded for each category.

The open category will be awarded by a small group of professional artists.

The people’s choice category will be awarded based on the highest number of votes made by the public.

Prizes are still to be announced and when finalized the full list of prizes per category will be published on www.sportandleisureministry.com.au.

Display and Set up of Entries

Size guidelines or time frames do apply to all entries.

	Min Size	Max Size
Photography	A4	A3
Sculpture	12" x 12"	negotiable with ECAF
Painting	8" x 12"	48" x 36"
Film	2 minutes	4 minutes
Poetry	1 page A4	2 pages A4

If a film entry uses music, the artist is required to prove authorization for that piece of music, so as copy write laws are not broken.

All artists are responsible for checking their entry has been set up by the ECAF committee. Every artwork must be ready to hang or be presented for display. Ready to hang means:

- framed with a hook
- velcro on back
- wire on back of artwork

It is the responsibility of the artist to pack away and remove their entry at the end of the festival. If entries are not collected, removed or arrangements made with the ECAF 5pm on Sunday the 31st July 2011 the ECAF committee will use their discretion on the removal of the entry.

Sale of Entries

If an artist wants to sell their artwork (painting, sculpture or photograph) the artist must inform the ECAF of their intent through the entry form.

ECAF will take payment for the items on behalf of the artist and will forward the sale amount within 14 days of the festival. GST is the personal responsibility of artists, other than hobbyists, to send the appropriate contribution to the ATO if their work is sold.

General Conditions of Entry

1. Expressions Creative Arts Festival (ECAF) is a joint project run by Churches of Christ Sport and Recreation Association and Baptist Churches WA. Monies raised will be used to assist in the administration costs and any profits raised will be donated to Compassion Australia.
 2. By completing the entry form, making the entry payment and delivering the entry to the Warwick Leisure Centre by Friday 15th July 2011, the artist has agreed to the terms and conditions of the “2011 Expressions Creative Arts Festival” and accepts that the conditions contained in this entry form create a binding agreement between ECAF and the artist.
 3. The judges selected by the ECAF committee have the final decision and no correspondence will be entered into.
 4. Any prizes awarded during the Festival are not transferable, replaceable or redeemable.
 5. All details on the entry form are true and correct.
 6. By entering the festival competition the artist agrees for the ECAF committee to use the entry for publicity of the festival or future advertising of upcoming ECAF's.
 7. All entries will be displayed at the Warwick Leisure Centre on Saturday 30th July 2011 2pm – 4pm and Sunday the 31st July 2011 12pm – 4pm.
 8. Exhibitors are responsible for their own insurance of works. All reasonable care will be taken but no responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage while in custody, transit, or for works not collected.
 9. Entries will not be accepted if:
 - The guidelines for entry are not adhered to.
 - Entry form is not completed.
 - Entries are not received by the closing date.
 - Any local, state or federal laws broken to create the artwork.
 - It is up to the discretion of the Expressions Festival Committee to not accept an entry if it is of a degrading or immoral theme.
